If you're not sure if you're on the Electoral Roll, the full current list is available in the Coffee Lounge.

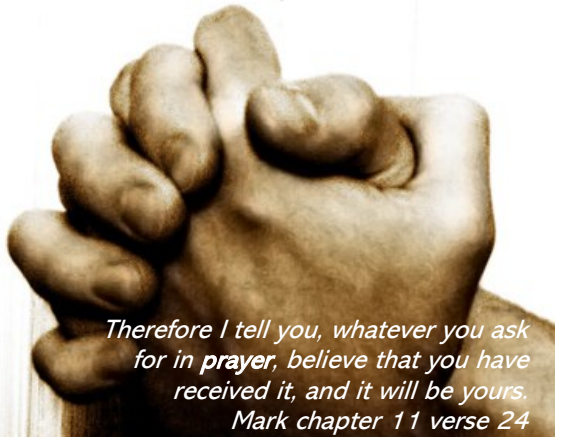
