Set up an obstacle course using chairs and other household objects and blindfold one person, have another guide them through it.

Read the Passage from **Luke 22: 1-30**, this talks about the last meal Jesus ate with his friends.

Questions:

- How much do you think the disciples trusted each other?
- What do you think the disciples were thinking when Jesus said, one of them would betray him? How would you have felt?
- If you knew what Judas was about to do, would you have invited him to dinner? Why/Why not?

Who are your trusted friends? Who might you have shared the last supper with if you were Jesus?
